KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we Adrian McDonald of Portage in Prince County in Prince Edward Island, Farmer, Leo McDonald of West Devon in Prince County aforesaid, Carpenter and *James McDonald of Portage aforesaid, Fisherman* are held and firmly bound unto the Judge of the Probate Court of, in and for Prince Edward Island, in virtue of his office, his successors and assigns in the sum of ~~thirty two~~ *twenty four* and *twenty eight* hundred dollars of lawful money of the Dominion of Canada, to be paid to the said Judge as aforesaid for the time being, for which payment, to be well and truly made we bind ourselves, and each of us by himself, for and in the whole, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, dated this 5th day of November in the year our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-One.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that if the above bounden Adrian McDonald Administrator of all and singular the Goods and Chattel and Credits of Alexander McDonald the deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Real Estat Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have, or shall come to the hands or possession of or knowledge of the said Adrian McDonald or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be filed in the Court when required by law so to do; and the same goods, Chattels and Credits and all other goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, at the time of his death, which at any time after shall come into the hands or possession of the said Adrian McDonald or into the hands or possession of ~~any other person~~ any other person for or persons for him do well and truly administer according to law; and further, do ~~make~~ make or cause to be made, a true and just account of the said Administration at or before the 5th day of May A.D. 1942 and all the rest and residue of the Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the Administrator's account, the same being first examined and allowed by the Court, or other Court of competent authority in that behalf, do deliver and pay over to such person or persons, respectively, and the said Court or other court of competent authority in that behalf, by Decree, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of this Act shall limit and appoint. And if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the said Deceased, and the said executor or ~~executors~~ executors therein named do exhibit the same into the said Court, making request to have it allowed and approved accordingly, if the said Adrian McDonald being thereunto required, do render and deliver the Letters of Administration (Probate of such Testament being first had and made) unto the said Court; then this obligation is to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
